- 3) Soil Fertility and its management

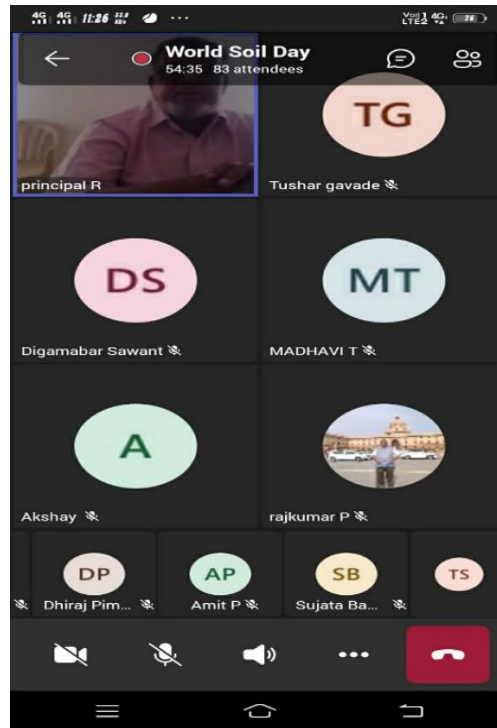
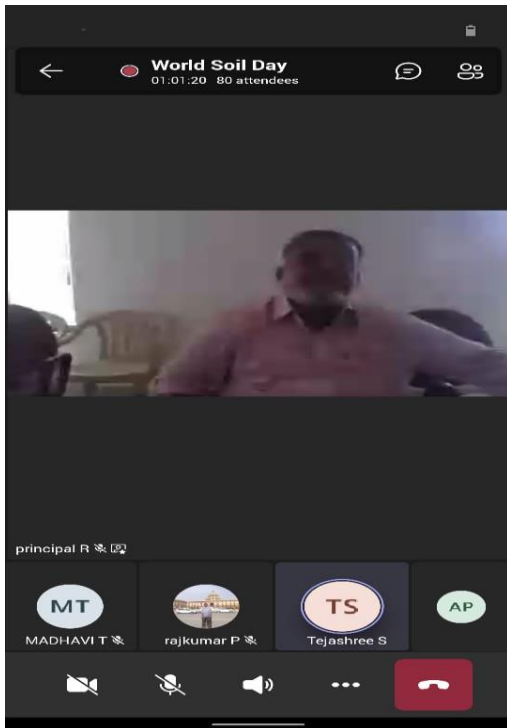

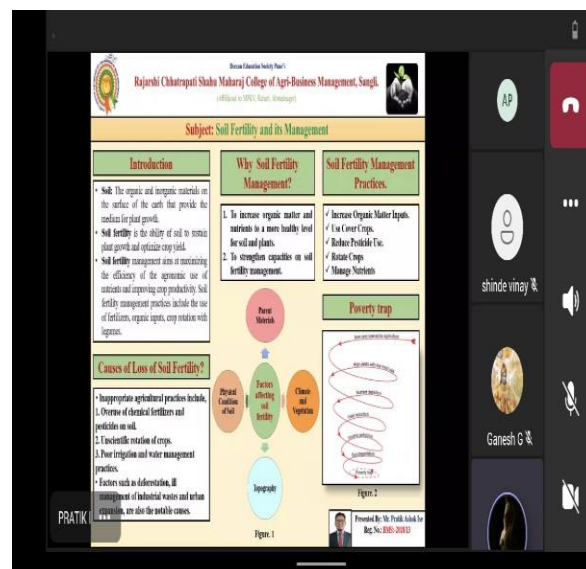
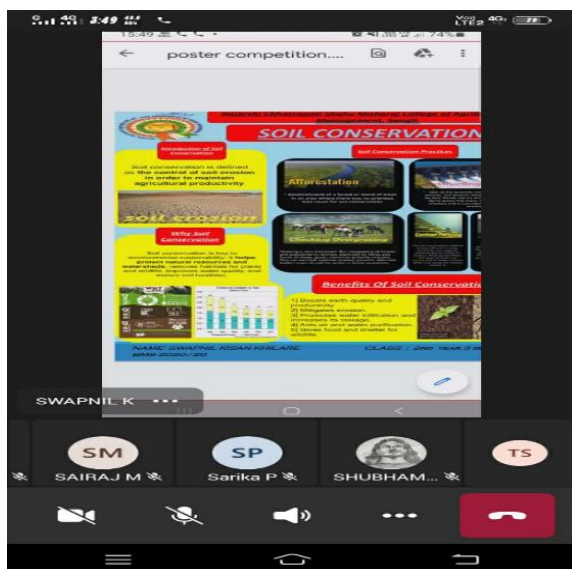
